War by Other Means: The Global Campaign to Delegitimize Israel: CAMERA Sponsors International Conference to Counter Bias

(BOSTON, Mass – August 3, 2010) Now, more than ever, Israel finds itself in a battle for fair treatment on the world stage. CAMERA (Committee for Accuracy in Middle East Reporting in America) is presenting a two-day conference, that brings together international experts to articulate the enormous challenges of the moment and to formulate constructive action to counter the biased assault. Featuring speakers such as Alan Dershowitz and Mark Steyn, this important gathering will take place October 10 – 11, 2010 in Metcalf Hall at Boston University. It is co-sponsored by the Florence and Chafetz Hillel House at Boston University. The East Brunswick Jewish Center is serving as an associate sponsor.

Renowned figures from journalism, academia, and other fields will focus on the role of the media, NGO's, the UN, academia and the mainline churches in threatening Israel's legitimacy. The urgent conditions in Europe will be examined as well. Hands-on sessions dedicated to training and activism will be offered for attendees. Featured speakers will also lead special workshop sessions geared exclusively towards students and young adults.

"The cumulative impact of the biased campaigns against Israel has had a major negative impact on European views of Israel and could, in time, affect American attitudes," said Andrea Levin, President of CAMERA. "This conference will provide a 'boot camp' experience for those who want to help. They will leave with a thorough level of knowledge of the key issues, and the tools they need to fight back -- to expose the hypocrisies of Israel's defamers and to promote the facts."

"The East Brunswick Jewish Center prides itself on its connection to Israel and its support of the Jewish homeland," stated the synagogue's rabbi, Rabbi Aaron D. Benson. "To effectively advocate for Israel, one must understand the challenges and complexities the country faces—especially in light of today's volatile political climate. CAMERA's upcoming conference will provide a uniquely valuable opportunity for education on this vital topic." Expert speakers will include Yigal Carmon (founder of MEMRI—Middle East Media Research Institute), Mark Steyn (best-selling author and columnist), Bret Stephens (Foreign Affairs correspondent, Wall Street Journal), Alan Dershowitz, Melanie Phillips (British columnist, Daily Mail), Daniel Pipes (Director, Middle East Forum), Andrea Levin (Executive Director of CAMERA), Kenneth Levin (Author of The Oslo Syndrome: Delusions of a People Under Siege), Gerald Steinberg (Director of NGO Monitor), Alex Safian (Associate Director of CAMERA), Anne Bayefsky (Senior Editor of Eye on the UN), Alvin H.
